### ***Section 39. of the Act - Persons who are not to be members of management committee***

- (1) Subject to section 40, this section applies to the following persons -
- (a) a person who is, according to the interpretation Act 1984 section 13D, a bankrupt or person whose affairs are under insolvency laws;
  - (b) a person who has been convicted, within or outside the State, of
    - (i) an indictable offence in relation to the promotion, formation or management of a body corporate; or
    - (ii) an offence involving fraud or dishonesty punishable by imprisonment for a period of not less than three months; or
    - (iii) an offence under Part 4 Division 3 or section 127 of the Act
- (2) A persons to whom this section applies must not, without leave of the Commissioner, accept an appointment or act as a member of a management committee of an incorporated association.

Penalty: a fine of \$10 000.
